B.) Set up and serve at funeral luncheons.



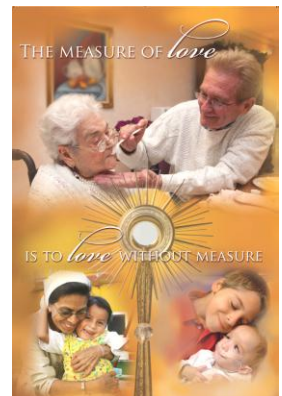
Habitat for Humanity® Eliminate poverty housing through the Matthew 25 home, which is built and funded by local churches. You can donate and/or help build the home.
